

**PATTERSON TOWNSHIP
DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY-EXTENSION**

WHEREAS, on or about March 24, 2020, a Declaration of Emergency was issued by the Board of Commissioners of Patterson Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the declaration was to continue in force for 30 days; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has extended its emergency orders through April 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this emergency and to protect the health, safety, and welfare of affected residents of Patterson Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned officials of Patterson Township, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 Pa.C.S. § 7501), as amended, do hereby Order that the March 24, 2020 Emergency Declaration shall continue until May 14, 2020 or until the threat or danger has passed or the pandemic has been dealt with to the extent that emergency conditions no longer exist..
