Items discussed:

- Discussion on agenda items.
- Commissioner Bartoe advised the Board that the County has provided an updated agreement for officers who work on the County Drug Task Force. This updated agreement would reimburse the Township \$60.00/hour. Discussion held on officer availability and training for this detail. Commissioner Bartoe advised that he would like to have a motion on the agenda for the Township to participate contingent on officer availability and experience.
- Commissioner Bartoe advised that they would like to have the Civil Service Commission hold testing to hire a part-time officer. Commissioner Bartoe has spoken with the Civil Service Commission Chairman and they are working to schedule a meeting to hold testing.
- Commissioner Bartoe advised that the exoneration of taxes is the last step for removing the property the Township purchased from the tax rolls – 72-133003005.
- Commissioner Bartoe advised that the COG conference will be held in August at the Hilton Garden Inn in Monaca.
- Commissioner Kristian provided an update on Lee's background and status of his training.
- Commissioner Kristian advised that we are still waiting on a start date for the roof repair.
- Foreman Campbell advised that the Road Program will begin on June 18, 2026.
- Foreman Campbell advised that all storm sewer work had been completed.
- The Board will need to approve the contract for road salt for the 2026-2027 winter season through COG.
- Civil Service Commission received a letter of interest from Rachel Dietz. A motion will be added to the agenda to appoint to the Civil Service Commission.
- Chief Bathgate advised that a bill was received for radio reprogramming; this bill will be placed on hold as this reprogramming was needed because the County provided the incorrect configuration for the initial programming. Chief Bathgate sent an email to the County requesting that they cover the cost for this invoice.
