### **Items discussed:**

- Public raised concern about speeding of School Street. They suggested a speed bump half way up the hill which requires a permit.
- Commissioner Bartoe reminded about the snow plows which would be a problem with the speed bump.
- Chief Stanislawski suggests stationing police vehicles in the area.
- Commissioner Kretschman suggests possibly making the street a “one way”.
- Thinking of talking to residents about a potential “one way” going from Darlington Road to 8<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Attorney Fawcett mentions a traffic study after talking to residents.
- A resolution has been created to purchase a parcel of land.
- Purchase of land for \$5,000 needs approval by the board.
- Ordinance in relation to chickens has been constructed for review. It entails an inspection once a year and a permit to acquire them. The number of chickens that can be owner will depend of the size of land. There are no roosters or other types of fowl.
- The ordinance for chickens is tabled till next meeting
- Attorney Fawcett mention potential other changes that could be made when changing the Zoning Ordinance.
- Attorney Fawcett mentions skill games and Commissioner Kristian would like to ban skill games in the Township. They cannot be prohibited rather they can be limited.
- Attorney Fawcett also mentions a solar farm. All agreed that there is no room for a solar farm.

- The police contract is tentatively agreed upon
- Commissioner Kretschman mentions a property within the Township has been backing up ever since a new house was built. There is potential damage to the sewer lines.
- Commissioner Kretschman mentions potentially putting the contractor on notice.
- Commissioner Kretschman suggest a motion to approve payment to add a valve to fix the problem. There will be an amount for valve by Thursday, August 8, 2024.
- There was a discussion on a plan for dumping.
