Items discussed:

- Commissioner Inman reviewed Commissioner Wagoner's Agenda Items. Commissioner Inman noted that he received an email from Attorney Fawcett advising that a grievance was filed by the Police and will be addressed by Commissioner Wagoner upon her return.
- Commissioner Bartoe asked that the Beaver County Association bill be removed from the agenda as it will not be a benefit to the Township.
- Commissioner Bartoe provided additional information relating to the Budget and discussion occurred regarding budget process and how budget numbers are determined. Discussion on numbers provided for the first reading. Commissioner Bartoe requested that each commissioner review their respective line items and let Township Administrator/Secretary Milnes know of any additions or change requests prior to the Monthly Meeting so they can be incorporated into the first reading. Commissioner Inman advised he may need more funds for the park; however, he will not know until he meets with LSSE to discuss the costs for completing access at the Ray Street entrance.
- Commissioner Bartoe advised that he is working with the Conservation District to assist with additional grant funding for MS4 and Park projects. Discussion on the Highland Ave. Rain Garden Project occurred; bids will be opened on Tuesday, October 10, 2023, at 11 a.m.
- Commissioner Inman advised that he will be meeting with the Committee for the Christmas house decorating contest on October 17, 2023, at 1:30 p.m. in the office.
- Commissioner Kretschman advised that he will be meeting with Eric Hoover to review additional plans for work off of Ray Street.
- Commissioner Kretschman advised that the recycling bins have been moved to the Quarry and are ready for leaf collection.
- Commissioner Kretschman advised that Anthony Campbell will start on 21 October 2023. Commissioner Kretschman also advised that he will be holding a short training on 21 October for the Snowplow Drivers, at which time they will review installation of the snowplows and operation of backhoe and other equipment.

- Commissioner Kristian advised he will be meeting with Kalcevic to look at the concrete in the Police garage where the water is believed to be coming in. There will be more to come on this once he is able to meet with them.
- Secretary/Administrator Milnes advised the Commissioners to review communications provided and provide comments to her if necessary.
